Introduction:

The Workshop on Herbal Nano Technology was held on 23 July 2021 at JKKMMRF's Annai JKK Sampoorani Ammal College of Pharmacy. The Workshop was organized by the Department of Pharmacy, and a total of 160 students participated. The purpose of the workshop was to provide attendees with an introduction to the basics of Herbal Nano Technology software as a tool for analyzing and organizing qualitative data. At the end of the workshop, all attendees received a certificate of completion.

Objectives:

The main objectives of the Seminar were to:

- Knowledge and use of plants as herbal medicines has occurred in various populations throughout human evolution, beginning when man was learning to select plants for food, and to relieve ailments and diseases.
- However during the second half of the twentieth century, especially in the western world, herbal medicines were gradually replaced by allopathic medicines.
- Allopathic treatments are currently more widely used than traditional medicines, especially in developed countries.
- According to the World Health Organization, 80% of people in developing countries depend on traditional medicinal practices to meet and/or supplement their basic health needs.

Participants:

The Workshop was open to all students at JKKMMRF's Annai JKK Sampoorani Ammal College of Pharmacy, and a total of 116 students participated. The attendees represented a range of academic disciplines within the field of pharmacy, including pharmacology, pharmaceutical chemistry, and pharmacy practice. Most of the attendees had some prior experience with qualitative research, but some were new to the field.

Format:

The seminar was structured as a combination of lectures, group discussions, and hands-on exercises. The lectures were led by an experienced researcher with expertise in complement system an overview, and the hands-on exercises were led by a trained facilitator. The seminar was held over one full days, with breaks in between to allow attendees to rest and ask questions.

Content:

The seminar covered a range of topics related to complement system. On the first day, attendees learned about the different types of qualitative data, including interview transcripts, focus group transcripts, and observational field notes. They also learned about the different approaches to analyzing qualitative data, including coding, memorying, and categorizing. On the second day, attendees learned how to know complement system to organize and analyze their qualitative data, including importing data, coding text, and creating visualizations.

Evaluation:



Conclusion:



HERBAL NANO TECHNOLOGY

INTRODUCTION

Nanotechnology is a field of applied science and technology which aims to develop devices and dosage forms in the range of 1 to 100 nm. The applications of nanotechnology for treatment, diagnosis, monitoring, and control of biological systems have recently been referred to as nanomedicine. The nanocarriers have been made of safe materials, including synthetic biodegradable polymers, lipids, and polysaccharides.

RECENT DEVELOPMENT

The nanoparticles have come forward as the capable approach in drug delivery systems for the well-organized delivery of drugs utilized in the treatment of various diseases such as cancer by crossing the reticuloendothelial system, enhanced permeability and retention effect, and tumor-specific targeting.

TOXICITY ISSUES

The change in the physicochemical and structural properties of engineered nano-sized materials with a decrease in size could be responsible for a number of material interactions that could lead to toxicological effects



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

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
