The seminar on Understand The Risk of Becoming an Entrepreneur was held on December 22th, 2017 at JKKMMRF's AnnaiSampoooraniAmmal College of Pharmacy. The seminar was organized by the Department of Pharmaceutical chemistry, and a total of 350 students participated. The purpose of the seminar was to provide attendees with an introduction to the basics of Understand the Risk of Becoming an Entrepreneur and to introduce them to the use of UNDERSTAND THE RISK OF BECOMING AN ENTREPRENEUR as a tool for analyzing and organizing qualitative data. At the end of the seminar, all attendees received a certificate of completion.

Objectives:

The main objectives of the seminar were to:

- Introduce attendees to the principles of identifying. Evaluating, mitigating, and trying out potential opportunities and strategies that may help you build or grow your business but could also lead to personal or professional loss.

- Provide an overview of the discrept types of qualitative data and how to collect and analyze them.

BECOMING AN ENTREPRENEUR through hands-on exercises Participants:

The seminar was open to all students at JKKMMRF's AnnaiSampooraniAmmal College of Pharmacy, and a total of 350 students participated. The attendees represented arrange of academic disciplines within the field of pharmacy, including pharmacology, pharmaceutical chemistry, and pharmacy practice. Most of the attendees had some prior experience with qualitative research, but some were new to the field.

Format:

The seminar was structured as a combination of lectures, group discussions, and hands-on exercises. The lectures were led by an experienced researcher with expertise in Understand the Risk of Becoming an Entrepreneur and the hands-on exercises were led by a trained facilitator. The seminar was held over one day, with breaks in between to allow attendees to rest and ask questions.

Content:

The seminar covered a range of topics related to the use of UNDERSTAND THE RISK OF BECOMING AN ENTREPRENEUR. On the day, attendees learned about the different types of qualitative data, including interview transcripts, focus group transcripts, and observational field notes. FINANCIAL RISK:

An entrepreneur will need funds to launch a business either in the form of loans from investors, their own savings, or funds from family. The founder will have to put their own "skin in the game.

STRATEGIC RISK:

An impressive business plan will appeal to investors. However, we live in a dynamic and fast-paced world where strategies can become outdated quickly.

TECHNOLOGY RISK:

New technologies are constantly emerging, particularly in the era of the Fourth Industrial Revolution. Some of these changes are characterized as "paradigm shifts" or "disruptive" technologies.

MARKET RISK:

COMPETITIVE RISK:

REPUTATIONAL RISK:

A business's reputation is everything, and this can be particularly so when a new business is launched and customers have preconceived expectations. If a new company disappoints consumers in the initial stages, it may never gain traction.

ENVIRONMENTAL, POLITICAL, AND ECONOMIC RISK:

Some things cannot be controlled by a good business plan or the right insurance.
Earthquakes, tornadoes, hurricanes, wars, and recessions are all risks that companies and new entrepreneurs may face.


