




7. CONCLUSION

This study appraises the knowledge, prevalence, attitudes and practices of specific occupations about varicose veins.

APPRAISAL OF KNOWLEDGE

Based on occupation, gender, and age, we appraise our respondent's level of knowledge. In which, we ascertained that teachers had a greater comprehension of varicose veins than others while street vendors have less expertise. Males have better expertise than female in gender specific fields. In terms of age specific knowledge, we determined that those between ages of 36-45 had adequate knowledge of varicose veins, while those above the age of 55 have a poor expertise. Then Knowledge assessment is validated using statistical interpretation.

APPRAISAL OF PREVALANCE

In addition, we appraises the prevalence of varicose vein symptoms according to gender, age, BMI, occupation, working hours, and number of years of working.

We scrutinize that females surpass males in terms of gender specific prevalence of varicose vein symptoms.

Peculiar to age specific prevalence, we ascertained that the age group over 55 had a higher prevalence than others, and via observation, we observed that prevalence rises with advancing age.

We scrutinize that the obese and overweight categories had a higher prevalence of varicose vein symptoms than the normal BMI range in terms of BMI-specific prevalence. Ergo, we found in our study that prevalence grows as BMI level rise.

Peculiar to standing hours specified prevalence, we found that individuals who stood for more

7. CONCLUSION

- Our research revealed a higher prevalence of chronic pain compared to acute pain among patients. Chronic pain significantly impacted various aspects of their daily lives, including sleep patterns, physical activity, and emotional well-being, leading to symptoms of irritability, anxiety, and depression.
- Furthermore, our findings indicated that patients who predominantly relied on overthe-counter NSAIDs for short-term pain relief, without consulting a medical professional, experienced a higher incidence of adverse side effects.
- The pain following chemotherapy persisted. While pain medications provided relief for acute pain, they were not effective in alleviating chronic pain for these patients.
- We educated the patients on safe and effective use of opioids, risk of addiction, overdose and abuse. We advised the patients not to double the dose in case they have skipped the dose. Also advised them to take their medication on correct time the correct dose as much as possible.

- Peptic Ulcer Disease (PUD) causes painful stomach or duodenal ulcers. Its impact on students' health and academics underscores the need for our study.
- Our study uncovers a paradox: low PUD prevalence but high symptom frequency among students, emphasizing the need for early symptom recognition and awareness due to PUD's elusive nature.
- Tailored education for 127 high-risk students enhanced PUD understanding, showcasing the potential of personalized healthcare education.
- Residential factors are key in PUD risk, with Paying Guest students showing higher susceptibility. Approximately 10.3% of students had PUD, mostly Hostellers (404 individuals), indicating a higher prevalence than Day Scholars.
- Lifestyle significantly impacts PUD susceptibility, notably diet and meal frequency.
 Paying Guest students' lifestyle changes show promise in mitigating PUD risk,
 emphasizing proactive health choices for prevention.
- Early detection is crucial, with symptoms like abdominal pain, bloating, and dietary changes identifying high-risk students. This highlights the value of symptom-based assessments in healthcare research.
- Our mission is knowledge empowerment through tailored interventions. Assessing knowledge showed significant improvements, emphasizing the power of informed health choices.
- Lack of time leads to meal skipping among students, highlighting the need for time management strategies and healthy eating promotion by educational institutions.

7. CONCLUSION

In this research study, we intended to evaluate the knowledge, attitude, practice, and awareness among females of a chosen demographic. By classifying the study participants into four groups based on factors including age, marital status, employment, and education, we evaluated their knowledge.

Among them, those between the age category of 18 to 25 demonstrated a better level of understanding on the knowledge of breast cancer.

For the purpose to evaluate the attitudes of the female participants in our study, we formulated a self-prepared questionnaire. And how the selected females responded to the question was analysed to identify their level of attitude. Subsequently, it generated an overall percentage of 80.2% positive responses, which is "GOOD" considering the significance of the breast cancer conditions.

Analysis of the correlation between the overail practice score and age category revealed that the age category of 36-45 was more effective than other categories in the percentage of practice toward breast cancer conditions.

We conducted a follow-up based on re-evaluating the knowledge regarding awareness. It revealed a reasonable improvement from an average score increased of 3.54 to 12.9.

We conclude our study by claiming that, our investigation allowed us to determine that about 28.6% of the female population lacked knowledge. By organizing awareness sessions for individuals who were lacking in knowledge, we were able to raise their level of understanding about breast cancer by providing pamphlets about breast cancer.

7. CONCLUSION

- In our study, we focused on comparing the net cost-benefit assessment of intravenous push and intravenous piggyback antibiotics administration which were prescribed to In-patients in the hospital.
- In our permitted hospital having the admission of lower family income patients. By doing this net-cost benefit analysis, they will be benefited.
- To ascertain whether medications were affordable for average citizens with any
 vocations, the occupation of the individuals was compared with their family income
 percentage.
- We monitored patient discomfort, allergic conditions, medication errors, and complications from intravenous antibiotic treatment throughout the research.
- Out of the IV antibiotics that have been categorized, six IV antibiotics have been administered through both IV push and IV piggyback technique.
- According to the evaluation of selected 6 TV antibiotics, that have been administered
 through both IV push and IV piggyback technique were Meropenem, Teicoplanin,
 Amoxicillin + Clavulanic Acid, Cefuroxime, Cefotaxime, And Cefoperazone +
 Sulbactam.
- Contrary to reports, administering these medications by IV push offers a financial advantage over administering via IV piggyback.
- Cost-benefit analysis forces us to outline every potential cost and benefit associated with the project.

CONCLUSION

- In our study, we aimed on evaluating the knowledge, attitude and deworming practices among parents of young children.
- > In order to evaluate parent's knowledge, we categorized them into groups based on their level of education and informational sources.
- > We found that on the basis of educational status, individuals who had completed their degree were showing higher level of knowledge, whereas from the source of information, individuals who have acquired information from friends and relatives were showing more in proportion, when compared to other categories.
 - Following the knowledge, we have assessed the attitude of the parents by using the questionnaire.
 - We have associated the level of deworming practices with the age of the child to identify the category of parents who are doing good practices. On measuring the level of deworming practices, we found that parents of age category 20-30 were doing "GOOD" practices.
 - Here, through our study we observed that most parents are believing that deworming practices should be initiated only when the children show the signs of

having worm infection.

7.CONCLUSION

- > The major goal of our study was to assess the level of knowledge, attitude, and practice about insulin delivery techniques, storage, and risk of lipohypertrophy among insulin administering patients in chosen sites.
- ➤ When we divided knowledge into three categories based on gender, age, and educational attainment, it became clear that people in the 30- to 45-year-old age group comprehended more about administering insulin.
- > In our investigation into participant attitudes, we analyzed these responses for our self-prepared questionnaire session and found that 43.18% of them were favorable positive responses.
- > Following the post-procedure follow-up, it was noted that there had been a considerable improvement in their attitude toward insulin delivery, with a response rate of 61.02%
- ➤ In our study, we further examined the storage and administration practices for insulin among diabetic patients, and we found that these practices were "GOOD" for patients between the ages of 46 and 65.
- ➤ It was observed that those between the ages of 46 and 65 had a higher risk of developing lipohypertrophy compared to other groups. Lipohypertrophy treatment was also discussed in the awareness session.
 - ➤ Hereby we conclude our study by claiming that people's degree of practice administering insulin injections is inadequate owing to hectic work schedules.

CONCLUSION

- We categorize the study's sample populations into four based on the level of their education.
- We evaluated the knowledge and effects on their psychological conditions of those who were more likely to be susceptible to anxiety and depression based on these categories.
- Upon analyzing the knowledge, we discovered that individuals with Degree had higher knowledge score than those in other categories.
- As part of our study's evaluation of knowledge, the number of years of marriage has been taken into consideration.
- Following, we evaluated the psychological well-being of the participants in our study who were more inclined to struggle with anxiety and depression.
- We assessed the individual's psychological condition by using a scoring method which was then compared with the knowledge of each participant.
- Our study focused on the relationship between educational attainment and mental health conditions like anxiety and depression.
- Examining psychological conditions based on probability of experiencing anxiety and depression revealed that anxiety was more frequently observed in people with below SSLC on the other hand depression was SSLC.
- Through our research, we came to the conclusion that those with the lower level of knowledge were more likely to develop psychiatric issues when undergoing IVF treatment.
- There should be some public information campaigns and educational sessions about infertility issues, especially for newlyweds for improving their knowledge about infertility conditions.

7. CONCLUSION

This study appraises the knowledge, prevalence, attitudes and practices of specific occupations about varicose veins.

APPRAISAL OF KNOWLEDGE

Based on occupation, gender, and age, we appraise our respondent's level of knowledge. In which, we ascertained that teachers had a greater comprehension of varicose veins than others while street vendors have less expertise. Males have better expertise than female in gender specific fields. In terms of age specific knowledge, we determined that those between ages of 36-45 had adequate knowledge of varicose veins, while those above the age of 55 have a poor expertise. Then Knowledge assessment is validated using statistical interpretation.

APPRAISAL OF PREVALANCE

In addition, we appraises the prevalence of varicose vein symptoms according to gender, age, BMI, occupation, working hours, and number of years of working.

We scrutinize that females surpass males in terms of gender specific prevalence of varicose vein symptoms.

Peculiar to age specific prevalence, we ascertained that the age group over 55 had a higher prevalence than others, and via observation, we observed that prevalence rises with advancing age.

We scrutinize that the obese and overweight categories had a higher prevalence of varicose vein symptoms than the normal BMI range in terms of BMI-specific prevalence. Ergo, we found in our study that prevalence grows as BMI level rise.

7. CONCLUSION

- Our research revealed a higher prevalence of chronic pain compared to acute pain among patients. Chronic pain significantly impacted various aspects of their daily lives, including sleep patterns, physical activity, and emotional well-being, leading to symptoms of irritability, anxiety, and depression.
- Furthermore, our findings indicated that patients who predominantly relied on overthe-counter NSAIDs for short-term pain relief, without consulting a medical professional, experienced a higher incidence of adverse side effects.
- The pain following chemotherapy persisted. While pain medications provided relief for acute pain, they were not effective in alleviating chronic pain for these patients.
- We educated the patients on safe and effective use of opioids, risk of addiction, overdose and abuse. We advised the patients not to double the dose in case they have skipped the dose. Also advised them to take their medication on correct time the correct dose as much as possible.

- Peptic Ulcer Disease (PUD) causes painful stomach or duodenal ulcers. Its impact on students' health and academics underscores the need for our study.
- Our study uncovers a paradox: low PUD prevalence but high symptom frequency among students, emphasizing the need for early symptom recognition and awareness due to PUD's elusive nature.
- Tailored education for 127 high-risk students enhanced PUD understanding, showcasing the potential of personalized healthcare education.
- Residential factors are key in PUD risk, with Paying Guest students showing higher susceptibility. Approximately 10.3% of students had PUD, mostly Hostellers (404 individuals), indicating a higher prevalence than Day Scholars.
- Lifestyle significantly impacts PUD susceptibility, notably diet and meal frequency.
 Paying Guest students' lifestyle changes show promise in mitigating PUD risk,
 emphasizing proactive health choices for prevention.
- Early detection is crucial, with symptoms like abdominal pain, bloating, and dietary changes identifying high-risk students. This highlights the value of symptom-based assessments in healthcare research.

7. CONCLUSION

In this research study, we intended to evaluate the knowledge, attitude, practice, and awareness among females of a chosen demographic. By classifying the study participants into four groups based on factors including age, marital status, employment, and education, we evaluated their knowledge.

Among them, those between the age category of 18 to 25 demonstrated a better level of understanding on the knowledge of breast cancer.

For the purpose to evaluate the attitudes of the female participants in our study, we formulated a self-prepared questionnaire. And how the selected females responded to the question was analysed to identify their level of attitude. Subsequently, it generated an overall percentage of 80.2% positive responses, which is "GOOD" considering the significance of the breast cancer conditions.

Analysis of the correlation between the overail practice score and age category revealed that the age category of 36-45 was more effective than other categories in the percentage of practice toward breast cancer conditions.

We conducted a follow-up based on re-evaluating the knowledge regarding awareness. It revealed a reasonable improvement from an average score increased of 3.54 to 12.9.

We conclude our study by claiming that, our investigation allowed us to determine that about 28.6% of the female population lacked knowledge. By organizing awareness sessions for individuals who were lacking in knowledge, we were able to raise their level of understanding about breast cancer by providing pamphlets about breast cancer.

7. CONCLUSION

- In our study, we focused on comparing the net cost-benefit assessment of intravenous push and intravenous piggyback antibiotics administration which were prescribed to In-patients in the hospital.
- In our permitted hospital having the admission of lower family income patients. By doing this net-cost benefit analysis, they will be benefited.
- To ascertain whether medications were affordable for average citizens with any
 vocations, the occupation of the individuals was compared with their family income
 percentage.
- We monitored patient discomfort, allergic conditions, medication errors, and complications from intravenous antibiotic treatment throughout the research.
- Out of the IV antibiotics that have been categorized, six IV antibiotics have been administered through both IV push and IV piggyback technique.
- According to the evaluation of selected 6 TV antibiotics, that have been administered
 through both IV push and IV piggyback technique were Meropenem, Teicoplanin,
 Amoxicillin + Clavulanic Acid, Cefuroxime, Cefotaxime, And Cefoperazone +
 Sulbactam.
- Contrary to reports, administering these medications by IV push offers a financial advantage over administering via IV piggyback.
- Cost-benefit analysis forces us to outline every potential cost and benefit associated with the project.

- > We found that on the basis of educational status, individuals who had completed their degree were showing higher level of knowledge, whereas from the source of information, individuals who have acquired information from friends and relatives were showing more in proportion, when compared to other categories.
 - Following the knowledge, we have assessed the attitude of the parents by using the questionnaire.
 - We have associated the level of deworming practices with the age of the child to identify the category of parents who are doing good practices. On measuring the level of deworming practices, we found that parents of age category 20-30 were doing "GOOD" practices.
 - Here, through our study we observed that most parents are believing that deworming practices should be initiated only when the children show the signs of

having worm infection.

7.CONCLUSION

- > The major goal of our study was to assess the level of knowledge, attitude, and practice about insulin delivery techniques, storage, and risk of lipohypertrophy among insulin administering patients in chosen sites.
- ➤ When we divided knowledge into three categories based on gender, age, and educational attainment, it became clear that people in the 30- to 45-year-old age group comprehended more about administering insulin.
- > In our investigation into participant attitudes, we analyzed these responses for our self-prepared questionnaire session and found that 43.18% of them were favorable positive responses.
- > Following the post-procedure follow-up, it was noted that there had been a considerable improvement in their attitude toward insulin delivery, with a response rate of 61.02%
- ➤ In our study, we further examined the storage and administration practices for insulin among diabetic patients, and we found that these practices were "GOOD" for patients between the ages of 46 and 65.
- ➤ It was observed that those between the ages of 46 and 65 had a higher risk of developing lipohypertrophy compared to other groups. Lipohypertrophy treatment was also discussed in the awareness session.
 - ➤ Hereby we conclude our study by claiming that people's degree of practice administering insulin injections is inadequate owing to hectic work schedules.

CONCLUSION

- We categorize the study's sample populations into four based on the level of their education.
- We evaluated the knowledge and effects on their psychological conditions of those who were more likely to be susceptible to anxiety and depression based on these categories.
- Upon analyzing the knowledge, we discovered that individuals with Degree had higher knowledge score than those in other categories.
- As part of our study's evaluation of knowledge, the number of years of marriage has been taken into consideration.
- Following, we evaluated the psychological well-being of the participants in our study who were more inclined to struggle with anxiety and depression.
- We assessed the individual's psychological condition by using a scoring method which was then compared with the knowledge of each participant.
- Our study focused on the relationship between educational attainment and mental health conditions like anxiety and depression.
- Examining psychological conditions based on probability of experiencing anxiety and depression revealed that anxiety was more frequently observed in people with below SSLC on the other hand depression was SSLC.
- Through our research, we came to the conclusion that those with the lower level of knowledge were more likely to develop psychiatric issues when undergoing IVF treatment.
- There should be some public information campaigns and educational sessions about infertility issues, especially for newlyweds for improving their knowledge about infertility conditions.

7. CONCLUSION

This study appraises the knowledge, prevalence, attitudes and practices of specific occupations about varicose veins.

APPRAISAL OF KNOWLEDGE

Based on occupation, gender, and age, we appraise our respondent's level of knowledge. In which, we ascertained that teachers had a greater comprehension of varicose veins than others while street vendors have less expertise. Males have better expertise than female in gender specific fields. In terms of age specific knowledge, we determined that those between ages of 36-45 had adequate knowledge of varicose veins, while those above the age of 55 have a poor expertise. Then Knowledge assessment is validated using statistical interpretation.

APPRAISAL OF PREVALANCE

In addition, we appraises the prevalence of varicose vein symptoms according to gender, age, BMI, occupation, working hours, and number of years of working.

We scrutinize that females surpass males in terms of gender specific prevalence of varicose vein symptoms.

Peculiar to age specific prevalence, we ascertained that the age group over 55 had a higher prevalence than others, and via observation, we observed that prevalence rises with advancing age.

We scrutinize that the obese and overweight categories had a higher prevalence of varicose vein symptoms than the normal BMI range in terms of BMI-specific prevalence. Ergo, we found in our study that prevalence grows as BMI level rise.

7. CONCLUSION

- Our research revealed a higher prevalence of chronic pain compared to acute pain among patients. Chronic pain significantly impacted various aspects of their daily lives, including sleep patterns, physical activity, and emotional well-being, leading to symptoms of irritability, anxiety, and depression.
- Furthermore, our findings indicated that patients who predominantly relied on overthe-counter NSAIDs for short-term pain relief, without consulting a medical professional, experienced a higher incidence of adverse side effects.
- The pain following chemotherapy persisted. While pain medications provided relief for acute pain, they were not effective in alleviating chronic pain for these patients.
- We educated the patients on safe and effective use of opioids, risk of addiction, overdose and abuse. We advised the patients not to double the dose in case they have skipped the dose. Also advised them to take their medication on correct time the correct dose as much as possible.

- Peptic Ulcer Disease (PUD) causes painful stomach or duodenal ulcers. Its impact on students' health and academics underscores the need for our study.
- Our study uncovers a paradox: low PUD prevalence but high symptom frequency among students, emphasizing the need for early symptom recognition and awareness due to PUD's elusive nature.
- Tailored education for 127 high-risk students enhanced PUD understanding, showcasing the potential of personalized healthcare education.
- Residential factors are key in PUD risk, with Paying Guest students showing higher susceptibility. Approximately 10.3% of students had PUD, mostly Hostellers (404 individuals), indicating a higher prevalence than Day Scholars.
- Lifestyle significantly impacts PUD susceptibility, notably diet and meal frequency.
 Paying Guest students' lifestyle changes show promise in mitigating PUD risk,
 emphasizing proactive health choices for prevention.
- Early detection is crucial, with symptoms like abdominal pain, bloating, and dietary changes identifying high-risk students. This highlights the value of symptom-based assessments in healthcare research.

7. CONCLUSION

In this research study, we intended to evaluate the knowledge, attitude, practice, and awareness among females of a chosen demographic. By classifying the study participants into four groups based on factors including age, marital status, employment, and education, we evaluated their knowledge.

Among them, those between the age category of 18 to 25 demonstrated a better level of understanding on the knowledge of breast cancer.

For the purpose to evaluate the attitudes of the female participants in our study, we formulated a self-prepared questionnaire. And how the selected females responded to the question was analysed to identify their level of attitude. Subsequently, it generated an overall percentage of 80.2% positive responses, which is "GOOD" considering the significance of the breast cancer conditions.

Analysis of the correlation between the overail practice score and age category revealed that the age category of 36-45 was more effective than other categories in the percentage of practice toward breast cancer conditions.

We conducted a follow-up based on re-evaluating the knowledge regarding awareness. It revealed a reasonable improvement from an average score increased of 3.54 to 12.9.

We conclude our study by claiming that, our investigation allowed us to determine that about 28.6% of the female population lacked knowledge. By organizing awareness sessions for individuals who were lacking in knowledge, we were able to raise their level of understanding about breast cancer by providing pamphlets about breast cancer.

- In our study, we focused on comparing the net cost-benefit assessment of intravenous push and intravenous piggyback antibiotics administration which were prescribed to In-patients in the hospital.
- In our permitted hospital having the admission of lower family income patients. By doing this net-cost benefit analysis, they will be benefited.
- To ascertain whether medications were affordable for average citizens with any
 vocations, the occupation of the individuals was compared with their family income
 percentage.
- We monitored patient discomfort, allergic conditions, medication errors, and complications from intravenous antibiotic treatment throughout the research.
- Out of the IV antibiotics that have been categorized, six IV antibiotics have been administered through both IV push and IV piggyback technique.
- According to the evaluation of selected 6 TV antibiotics, that have been administered
 through both IV push and IV piggyback technique were Meropenem, Teicoplanin,
 Amoxicillin + Clavulanic Acid, Cefuroxime, Cefotaxime, And Cefoperazone +
 Sulbactam.

CONCLUSION

- In our study, we aimed on evaluating the knowledge, attitude and deworming practices among parents of young children.
- > In order to evaluate parent's knowledge, we categorized them into groups based on their level of education and informational sources.
- > We found that on the basis of educational status, individuals who had completed their degree were showing higher level of knowledge, whereas from the source of information, individuals who have acquired information from friends and relatives were showing more in proportion, when compared to other categories.
 - Following the knowledge, we have assessed the attitude of the parents by using the questionnaire.
 - We have associated the level of deworming practices with the age of the child to identify the category of parents who are doing good practices. On measuring the level of deworming practices, we found that parents of age category 20-30 were doing "GOOD" practices.
 - Here, through our study we observed that most parents are believing that deworming practices should be initiated only when the children show the signs of

having worm infection.

7.CONCLUSION

- > The major goal of our study was to assess the level of knowledge, attitude, and practice about insulin delivery techniques, storage, and risk of lipohypertrophy among insulin administering patients in chosen sites.
- ➤ When we divided knowledge into three categories based on gender, age, and educational attainment, it became clear that people in the 30- to 45-year-old age group comprehended more about administering insulin.
- > In our investigation into participant attitudes, we analyzed these responses for our self-prepared questionnaire session and found that 43.18% of them were favorable positive responses.
- > Following the post-procedure follow-up, it was noted that there had been a considerable improvement in their attitude toward insulin delivery, with a response rate of 61.02%
- ➤ In our study, we further examined the storage and administration practices for insulin among diabetic patients, and we found that these practices were "GOOD" for patients between the ages of 46 and 65.
- ➤ It was observed that those between the ages of 46 and 65 had a higher risk of developing lipohypertrophy compared to other groups. Lipohypertrophy treatment was also discussed in the awareness session.
 - ➤ Hereby we conclude our study by claiming that people's degree of practice administering insulin injections is inadequate owing to hectic work schedules.

CONCLUSION

- We categorize the study's sample populations into four based on the level of their education.
- We evaluated the knowledge and effects on their psychological conditions of those who were more likely to be susceptible to anxiety and depression based on these categories.
- Upon analyzing the knowledge, we discovered that individuals with Degree had higher knowledge score than those in other categories.
- As part of our study's evaluation of knowledge, the number of years of marriage has been taken into consideration.
- Following, we evaluated the psychological well-being of the participants in our study who were more inclined to struggle with anxiety and depression.
- We assessed the individual's psychological condition by using a scoring method which was then compared with the knowledge of each participant.
- Our study focused on the relationship between educational attainment and mental health conditions like anxiety and depression.
- Examining psychological conditions based on probability of experiencing anxiety and depression revealed that anxiety was more frequently observed in people with below SSLC on the other hand depression was SSLC.
- Through our research, we came to the conclusion that those with the lower level of knowledge were more likely to develop psychiatric issues when undergoing IVF treatment.
- There should be some public information campaigns and educational sessions about infertility issues, especially for newlyweds for improving their knowledge about infertility conditions.

7. CONCLUSION

This study appraises the knowledge, prevalence, attitudes and practices of specific occupations about varicose veins.

APPRAISAL OF KNOWLEDGE

Based on occupation, gender, and age, we appraise our respondent's level of knowledge. In which, we ascertained that teachers had a greater comprehension of varicose veins than others while street vendors have less expertise. Males have better expertise than female in gender specific fields. In terms of age specific knowledge, we determined that those between ages of 36-45 had adequate knowledge of varicose veins, while those above the age of 55 have a poor expertise. Then Knowledge assessment is validated using statistical interpretation.

APPRAISAL OF PREVALANCE

In addition, we appraises the prevalence of varicose vein symptoms according to gender, age, BMI, occupation, working hours, and number of years of working.

We scrutinize that females surpass males in terms of gender specific prevalence of varicose vein symptoms.

Peculiar to age specific prevalence, we ascertained that the age group over 55 had a higher prevalence than others, and via observation, we observed that prevalence rises with advancing age.

We scrutinize that the obese and overweight categories had a higher prevalence of varicose vein symptoms than the normal BMI range in terms of BMI-specific prevalence. Ergo, we found in our study that prevalence grows as BMI level rise.

7. CONCLUSION

- Our research revealed a higher prevalence of chronic pain compared to acute pain among patients. Chronic pain significantly impacted various aspects of their daily lives, including sleep patterns, physical activity, and emotional well-being, leading to symptoms of irritability, anxiety, and depression.
- Furthermore, our findings indicated that patients who predominantly relied on overthe-counter NSAIDs for short-term pain relief, without consulting a medical professional, experienced a higher incidence of adverse side effects.
- The pain following chemotherapy persisted. While pain medications provided relief for acute pain, they were not effective in alleviating chronic pain for these patients.
- We educated the patients on safe and effective use of opioids, risk of addiction, overdose and abuse. We advised the patients not to double the dose in case they have skipped the dose. Also advised them to take their medication on correct time the correct dose as much as possible.

- In our study, we focused on comparing the net cost-benefit assessment of intravenous push and intravenous piggyback antibiotics administration which were prescribed to In-patients in the hospital.
- In our permitted hospital having the admission of lower family income patients. By doing this net-cost benefit analysis, they will be benefited.
- To ascertain whether medications were affordable for average citizens with any
 vocations, the occupation of the individuals was compared with their family income
 percentage.
- We monitored patient discomfort, allergic conditions, medication errors, and complications from intravenous antibiotic treatment throughout the research.
- Out of the IV antibiotics that have been categorized, six IV antibiotics have been administered through both IV push and IV piggyback technique.
- According to the evaluation of selected 6 TV antibiotics, that have been administered
 through both IV push and IV piggyback technique were Meropenem, Teicoplanin,
 Amoxicillin + Clavulanic Acid, Cefuroxime, Cefotaxime, And Cefoperazone +

- In our study, we aimed on evaluating the knowledge, attitude and deworming practices among parents of young children.
- > In order to evaluate parent's knowledge, we categorized them into groups based on their level of education and informational sources.
- > We found that on the basis of educational status, individuals who had completed their degree were showing higher level of knowledge, whereas from the source of information, individuals who have acquired information from friends and relatives were showing more in proportion, when compared to other categories.
 - Following the knowledge, we have assessed the attitude of the parents by using the questionnaire.
 - We have associated the level of deworming practices with the age of the child to identify the category of parents who are doing good practices. On measuring the level of deworming practices, we found that parents of age category 20-30 were doing "GOOD" practices.
 - Here, through our study we observed that most parents are believing that deworming practices should be initiated only when the children show the signs of

having worm infection.

CONCLUSION

- We categorize the study's sample populations into four based on the level of their education.
- We evaluated the knowledge and effects on their psychological conditions of those who were more likely to be susceptible to anxiety and depression based on these categories.
- Upon analyzing the knowledge, we discovered that individuals with Degree had higher knowledge score than those in other categories.
- As part of our study's evaluation of knowledge, the number of years of marriage has been taken into consideration.
- Following, we evaluated the psychological well-being of the participants in our study who were more inclined to struggle with anxiety and depression.
- We assessed the individual's psychological condition by using a scoring method which was then compared with the knowledge of each participant.
- Our study focused on the relationship between educational attainment and mental health conditions like anxiety and depression.
- Examining psychological conditions based on probability of experiencing anxiety and depression revealed that anxiety was more frequently observed in people with below SSLC on the other hand depression was SSLC.
- Through our research, we came to the conclusion that those with the lower level of knowledge were more likely to develop psychiatric issues when undergoing IVF treatment.
- There should be some public information campaigns and educational sessions about infertility issues, especially for newlyweds for improving their knowledge about infertility conditions.
